## **Catching My Breath** On the Way Back to Beautiful

**SCITUATE, MA** — The Studio Scituate Harbor will host an opening reception on Friday, June 19, for *Catching My Breath*, a solo exhibition of new abstract works by South Shore artist Emily Loverin, also known artistically as eLove.

A Scituate native now living in Marshfield, Loverin is an artist, writer, interior designer, and storyteller whose expressive abstract paintings explore transformation, rediscovery, softness, strength, and the emotional beauty found in becoming. The collection features both large-scale abstract florals and geometric-based compositions filled with movement, color, texture, and layered emotion.

Deeply influenced by coastal New England landscapes and the evolving chapters of her own life, Loverin's work reflects an artistic voice that is bold yet deeply human — honoring growth not as a perfect or linear process, but as something textured, honest, and alive.

The exhibit also marks the evolution of Loverin's artistic signature into "eLove," a personal and creative turning point representing what she describes as "a softer, stronger, and more honest devotion" to herself, her story, and the life still unfolding ahead of her.

“This body of work feels rooted in gratitude,” says Loverin. “It’s about freedom, reinvention, courage, beauty, and learning to hold softness and strength at the same time.”

The exhibition marks a new creative chapter not only for the artist, but also for The Studio Scituate Harbor, a photography studio and creative gathering space founded by photographer Danielle Robertson. Designed to foster artistic connection and community within Scituate Harbor, the studio continues expanding its role as a home for exhibitions, workshops, and collaborative creative experiences.

“Emily and I grew up in Scituate and graduated together more than 30 years ago, but I didn’t see her artwork until last year — just as she was beginning to share it publicly and I was opening the studio,” says Robertson. “There was something incredibly serendipitous about that timing. Her work immediately stopped me in my tracks. It’s bold, emotional, intelligent, and deeply alive, and this exhibition feels like the beginning of the kind of creative collaboration and artistic community I’ve always envisioned for the studio.”

The opening reception will take place Friday, June 19, from 7-9pm at The Studio Scituate Harbor in Scituate Harbor Village. Guests will have the opportunity to meet the artist, experience the collection, and celebrate an evening of art, creativity, and community on the South Shore.

A portion of proceeds from *Catching My Breath* will go toward the **Creative Free Library** – The Studio’s art book exchange built out of up-cycled microwaves (more below).

The exhibit will remain on view through July 31.

## About The Studio Scituate Harbor

Danielle Robertson opened The Studio Scituate Harbor in June 2025 as the home of her photography practice and as a creative space for community and collaboration. Guided by her mission “*To Practice, Promote, and Support Creativity for All*,” The Studio was created to be the kind of artistic space Robertson wished existed while growing up in Scituate.

In addition to photoshoots and exhibitions, the Studio has hosted community events, student-centered creative programming, and interactive public installations. The space recently

welcomed students for the Scituate High School Poetry Slam and served as a filming location for a student-produced film project.

Robertson is currently building a **Creative Free Library** out of up-cycled microwaves. The library will be a collection of art books available to the kids and teens who gather near the studio; a colorful (and weather-proof) community resource where anyone can take or leave books dedicated to art, music, and crafting. A portion of proceeds from *Catching My Breath* will help support this initiative.
